Center Township Board of Supervisors Regular Meeting Minutes March 11, 2020 6:30 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Ronald Flatt called the Regular Meeting, of the Center Township Board of Supervisors, to order at 6:35 p.m. The meeting was held at the Unionville Volunteer Fire Company Firehall, 102 Mahood Road, Butler PA 16001.

ROLL CALL:

In addition to Chairman Flatt, present were Vice Chairman Philip Wulff; Supervisors Edward Latuska and Robert Sloan; Township Solicitor Michael Gallagher; Township Engineer David Heath; and Township Secretary/Treasurer Anthony Amendolea. Supervisor Alan Smallwood was absent.

PUBLIC TO BE HEARD:

A. Mr. Nathan Wulff, Unionville Fire Chief 2: Mr. Wulff presented the Unionville Volunteer Fire Company report for January 2020 as follows:

- A. Weaver Homes Rezoning Hearing February 10, 2020: Latuska motioned approving the minutes of the Weaver Homes Rezoning Hearing held on Monday, February 10, 2020. Sloan seconded. Motion carried.
- B. Agenda Setting Meeting February 10, 2020: Latuska motioned approving the minutes of the Agenda Setting Meeting held on Monday, February 10, 2020. Flatt seconded. Motion carried.
- C. Regular Meeting February 12, 2020: Latuska motioned correcting, (1) Public to be Heard, Item C, by adding "Mr. Pringle displayed persistent and inappropriate action during the meeting by ignoring Chairman Flatt's gaveling to stop the conversation" and (2) New Business, Item H which reads "King showed" to read "King failed to show", the

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minutes of the Regular Meeting held on Wednesday, February 12, 2020. Flatt seconded. Motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

- A. February 2020: Flatt motioned approving the February 2020 Treasurer's Report. Latuska seconded. Motion carried.
- B. Warrant List 20-02-04: Latuska motioned approving Warrant List 20-02-04. Sloan seconded. Motion carried.
- C. Warrant List 20-03-05: Latuska motioned approving Warrant List 20-03-05. Sloan seconded. Motion carried.

ZONING REPORT: February 2020: Construction costs were \$90,600.00 fees collected were \$2,850.00.

SUBDIVISION & LAND DEVELOPMENTS:

- A. Douthett Minor Subdivision No. 2020-02-03, Final, Expires: 05/25/2020: Ms. Cheryl Hughes presented. Ms. Douthett proposes subdividing 159 East Brewster Road (Center Township Map 060-2F104-9BA) consisting of 17.58 acres (m/l) to create two lots with the final arrangement being Lot 1 consisting of 10.00 acres (m/l) and Lot 2 consisting of 7.58 acres (m/l). She requests a modification from Chapter 14, Article IV, 14-403B.3.e of the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance for providing contours on the plan. The Butler County Planning Commission had no comment per letter dated February 25, 2020. Township Engineer Reidenbacher's comments are (Ms. Cheryl Hughes' comments are italicized):
 - 1. The rock sump details shall be removed from the proposed subdivision plan. (We removed the on-lot sump detail since it should be part of the building permit process.)
 - 2. The applicant has requested a modification from Chapter 14, Article IV, 14-403B.3.e of the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance for providing contours on the plan. (We take no exception to this request.)

In addition the non-building waiver on the remnant and the Highway Occupancy Permit, since Brewster Road is not a state road, notes were removed.

The Planning Commission recommended granting the modification from, Chapter 14, Article IV, 14-403B.3.e of the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance, to provide contours on the plan.

The Planning Commission, based on Township Engineer Reidenbach's recommendation and contingent on the approval of the Sewage Facilities Planning Module Component 3 from the Department of Environmental Protection, recommended approval of the Douthett Minor Subdivision No. 2020-02-03.

Flatt motioned granting the modification from, Chapter 14, Article XIV, Section 14-403B.3.e of the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance, to provide contours on the plan.

Sloan motioned, contingent on receipt of Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection's approval of the Sewage Facilities Planning Module Component 3, granting final approval for the Douthett Minor Subdivision No. 2020-02-03. Latuska seconded. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

A. Daniels Ag Security Resolution No. 2020-03-10: Mark A Daniels submitted an application to add forty-four and eighty-eight hundreds (44.88) acres (m/l) (Center Township Map 060-2F108-11C) to the Center Township Agricultural Security Area on August 26, 2019. The Board permitted the one hundred eighty (180) days to expire. Flatt motioned adopting the Daniels Agricultural Security Resolution No. 2020-03-10 to add forty-four and eighty-eight (44.88) acres (m/l) (Center Township Map 060-2F108-11C) to the Center Township Agricultural Security Area. Latuska seconded. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Authorize Ad for "BYOB" Establishments Ordinance: Flatt motioned authorizing placement of an ad in the Butler Eagle edition for Sunday, March 29, 2020. Latuska seconded. Motion carried.
- B. Butler County Spring Convention 05/21/2020 Butler Country Club \$28: The Butler Country Spring Convention, which is held at the Butler Country Club, is scheduled for Thursday, May 21, 2020 at a cost of \$28.00 per attendee. Flatt motioned authorizing Randall Brown to attend the Butler Country Spring Convention on Thursday, May 21, 2020 at a cost of \$28.00. Latuska seconded. Motion carried.
- C. Multi-Municipal UCC Appeals Board Agreement Summit Township:
 - 1. Uniform Construction Code Board of Appeals Multi-Municipal Agreement: Summit Township, Butler County has requested to use our Uniform Construction Code Board of Appeals. Flatt motioned (1), based on Township Solicitor Gallagher's recommendation, waiving the requirement for the hearing to be held in Center Township (Section 6) and (2) accepting the Multi-Municipal Uniform Construction Appeals Board Agreement with Summit Township. Latuska seconded. Motion carried.
 - 2. Multi-Municipal UCC Appeals Board Summit Township Ordinance No. 2020-03-02: Latuska motioned adopting the Multi-Municipal UCC Appeals Board Summit Township Ordinance No. 2020-03-02. Wulff seconded. Motion carried.
- D. Purchase of Copier: Township Secretary/Treasurer Amendolea had preventative maintenance performed on the current copier on February 20, 2020. The repairman mentioned that it was getting difficult to get parts. Two (2) quotes were provided by Hagan Business Machines of Butler, Inc, as follows:

Both copiers include a maintenance agreement which includes toner, drums, parts and service. Flatt motioned authorizing purchase of the Copystar CS 3253ci (color) at a cost of \$5,998.00. Latuska seconded. Motion carried.

E. EADS Group Comprehensive Plan Agreement: The Board authorized Tracey Frampton, EADS Group, to continue with the comprehensive plan which was started by Mr. Richard Grossman. EADS Group established a rate of \$24,905.00 to be completed within six (6) months. On January 27, 2020, Sloan authorized Tracey Frampton to proceed. The first

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meetings will be held on Tuesday, March 24, 2020 at the Municipal Office. The remaining meetings will be held on the third Wednesday of each month. Sloan motioned (1) ratifying the approval of Mr. Tracey Frampton, EADS Group, to complete the comprehensive plan for \$24,905.00 to be completed within six (6) months and (2) authorize Flatt to sign the agreement. Latuska seconded. Motion carried.

F. Application for Public Fire Hydrant: Pennsylvania American Water Company is replacing water line along North Drive. They asked if the Township would like to place any fire hydrants on the new line. The Unionville Volunteer Fire Company recommends placing a hydrant at the intersection of North Drive (T-300) and Middle Drive (T-304) and a hydrant at the intersection of North Drive (T-300) and Shady Drive (T-305). Latuska motioned authorizing the placement of a hydrant at the intersection of North Drive (T-300) and Middle Drive (T-304) and a hydrant at the intersection of North Drive (T-300) and Shady Drive (T-305). Sloan seconded. Motion carried.

Sloan seconded. Motion carried.

- F. North Benbrook Road (T-602) Culvert Replacement Project: The Board requests that the North Benbrook Road (T-602) Culvert Replacement Project be advertised and receive bids for Monday, May 11, 2020. Flatt motioned authorizing rebidding the North Benbrook Road (T-602) Culvert Replacement Project to be advertised and bid opening scheduled for Monday, May 11, 2020 not to exceed \$21,000.00. Latuska seconded. Motion carried.

- A. 2020 Census: Flatt contacted Butler County Mapping concerning the Township border in the Westwood Manor III area. He will follow up with Ms. Donna Armahizer. In addition, he will discuss with Butler Township of changing the border so Duffy Highlands would be entirely in Center Township.
- B. Boy Scouts Troop 30: Latuska reported that Smallwood scheduled Boy Scouts Troop 30 for a litter pickup along Township roads for Saturday, May 30, 2020 and Sunday, May 31, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- C. Elected Auditors: Kenneth Frenchak was appointed at the meeting held on Wednesday, February 12, 2020. He declined the position on Monday, March 9, 2020.
