

PLANNING COMMISSION

Regular Meeting March 25, 2009 6:30 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER:

The regular meeting, of the Center Township Planning Commission, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Ken Frenchak. The meeting was held at the Township Building at 419 Sunset Drive, Butler, PA 16001

ROLL CALL:

APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

MINUTES:

NEW BUSINESS:

1. First United Methodist Church Conditional Use- John Stokes represented the application for a conditional use that would convert the old Friedman's Store into a worship hall.
