OLD BUSINESS:

A. Crawford Ag Security Resolution No. 2019-08-07: Dennis D. Jr. and Cindy S. Crawford submitted an application to add 13.446 acres (m/l) (Center Township Map 060-3F43-8) to Center Township Ag Security Area on February 13, 2019. The Board permitted the one hundred eighty (180) days to expire. Latuska motioned adopting the Crawford Ag Security Resolution No. 2019-08-07 to add 13.446 acres (m/l) (Center Township Map 060-3F43-8) to the Center Township Ag Security Area. Sloan seconded. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A. Maintenance Facility Loan: On January 29, 2010, the Board of Supervisors borrowed \$2,000,000.00 from NexTier Bank for twenty (20) years at a rate of 4.17 percent. On July 1, 2013, the Board negotiated with NexTier Bank to reduce the interest rate to 1.49 percent. On July 1, 2018, the interest rate increased to 2.337 percent due to the automatic five (5) year adjustment. The Board is in the position to pay off the debt (\$364,182.78) on August 30, 2019. The original pay off date was November 29, 2029. The 2.5 millage dedicated to the Debt Service fund will be diverted to the General Fund (1 mill) and the Capital Projects fund (1.5 mills) effective January 1, 2020. Flatt motioned to (1) transfer \$165,000.00 from the General Fund to the Debt Service Fund and (2) pay off the Maintenance Facility Loan on August 30, 2019 in the amount of \$364,182.78. Wulff seconded. Motion carried.
- B. Purchase of AED: The Safety Committee requests purchasing an AED for the 2005 Dodge Ram 5500 Utility truck since it is always on the work sites. Flatt motioned authorizing Wulff to oversee the purchase, if necessary, of an AED in an amount of not more than \$2,000.00. Smallwood seconded. Motion carried.
- C. Ms. Anita "Faye" Wulff Memorial Donation: Wulff's mother passed away on Monday, August 5, 2019. Flatt motioned authorizing a donation of fifty (\$50.00) to Saint Johns Reformed Church. Sloan seconded. Wulff abstained. Motion carried 4 to 0.

PUBLIC WORKS:

A. Flagger Training - 9/12/19 - Moon Township - \$50: Public Works Foreman Brewster requests the road crew attend a flagger training course due to their certification will expire. Employees Bryan Blakeley, Randall Brown, Michael Iscrupe and Jared Smith will attend at a

ENGINEER'S REPORT:

A. Veterans Administration/Cambridge Stormwater: Township Engineer Heath reported plans were sent to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection on July 25, 2019 per

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consent order. On Wednesday, August 7, 2019, a meeting was held with the Herold's to discuss the changes. Heath stated the review should be completed within two (2) to three (3) weeks.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT:

A. Presbyterian SeniorCare Network: Sunbury Fields currently make payment in lieu of taxes to the Township each year in the amount of \$1,000.00. Since they are refinancing for renovations, they must file as "for profit" corporation. Township Solicitor Gallagher will attend a meeting with Butler Area School District for more information.

MISCELLANEOUS:

A. Noise Complaint: Mr. Pat Tessaro attended the agenda setting meeting held on Monday, August 12, 2019 to complain about loud music at 507 Sunset Drive. Wulff and Smallwood talked to the concerned parties.
