ARTICLE VI

OBSTRUCTION OF INTERSECTIONS

History: Adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Center Township as Ordinance No. 2024-06-02, June 12, 2024

§17-601 Definitions

- A. CLEAR SIGHT TRIANGLE: A triangular area of unobstructed vision at street intersections, having as its sides, two (2) perpendicular street lines, and a line established between a point on each street line a given distance from the intersection. (See Figure #5, Exhibit B)
- B. RIGHT-OF-WAY: The legally established right-of-way of any dedicated or adopted street or road and any right-of-way dedicated for public use, including but not limited to utility easements, sanitary sewer easements and access easements and storm water management easements.
- C. STREET: Any public street, avenue, road, square, alley, highway or other public place located in the Township of Center and established for the use of vehicles, including the entire legal right-of-way of the street.

§17-602 Requirements

- A. No hedges shall be permitted to be planted in the front of the property that exceeds four (4') feet in height.
- B. Hedges must be outside the State and/or Township Right-of-Way.
- C. Trees may not be planted within the State and/or Township Right-of-Way.
- D. Existing trees and future growing trees must be trimmed on a regular basis to maintain the Clear Site Triangle to a height of ten (10) feet above road grade.
- E. Property owners are responsible for the maintenance and upkeep for hedges and trees subject to this Article.
